You are not required to be fit to start as Karate training is designed to help you gain fitness and flexibility. Disability does not exclude you from **IKC**. You will be given advice and training to succeed in becoming fit or fitter. You will require loose fitting clothing to start. i.e. tracksuit, jogging bottoms & tee shirt. Once you decide to continue training, you can obtain the correct clothing and equipment from your instructors. (Price list below)

After 3 lessons you will be required to apply for a licence. This is a ruling by the **EKF** and is a registration with them. You must do this so that you can grade and progress to the next level and if you want to, take part in competitions. Your licence will be recognised worldwide should you ever wish to train or compete abroad.
